## DEADLINES



"By" is used to describe an action or event that happens on or before a particular moment.

e.g. We expect to make a decision by the end of November.

e.g. Could you send me the report by 5 pm, please? e.g. We need to let everyone know about the meeting by Monday morning.

## **PERIODS OF TIME**



We use "until" to talk about the <u>period of time</u> from a starting point until a deadline or the end of some period of time.

e.g. I have 4 hours until this report is due. e.g. The tests will continue until November next year. e.g. I can give you until Friday to prepare this manuscript.
