Positive	Negative	Questions
I/He/She/It was late.	I/He/She/It wasn't late.	Was I/he/she/it late?
You/We/They were late.	You/We/They weren't late.	Were you/we/they late?

Example Dialogue

Carol: Sorry I'm late. I was in a meeting about Q2 sales.

Jack: Oh, was that this afternoon?

Carol: Yes, it was held in the main conference room.

Jack: Was it good?

Carol: Yes, the presenters were really interesting, and there were lots of good questions at the end.

Jack: Were there many people there?

Carol: There were only a few people. It was a really good meeting.
