Positive	Negative	Questions
Subject + verb	Subject + do/does not + verb	Do/Does + subject + verb
They work for Micron.	I don't/do not work for Samsung.	Do I/you/we/they work for Micron?
He works for Micron.	He doesn't/ does not work for Samsung.	Does he/she/it work for Micron?
