#### **MOVE IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION!**

What do you say if you want to know where something is? If you need to go somewhere but aren't sure how to get there, what do you do? Today we will cover expressions for asking about location and direction.

### **EXAMPLES**

#### Location

Where is ~

e.g.? Where is the bank?)

Next to

**Behind** 

In front of

Across (from)

Above

**Below** 

On the X (first, second, etc) floor

X is (next to, behind, in front of, across from, above, below) Y e.g. The bank is **next to** the Lawson

## **Direction**


How do I get to~?

e.g.. How do I get to the supplier's office?

Go straight (for x blocks, x miles/km)

Turn left/right (at)

Go past / over / under ~





#### **EXAMPLE DIALOGUE**

#### **Conversation 1**

**Brian**: Hey Toshiko, can I ask you a question? **Toshiko**: Sure Brian, what can I do for you?

Brian: I need to go to the station but I'm not sure where it is.

Toshiko: The station is next to the Hotel and across from the 7-11.

**Brian**: Is it the 7-11 behind the karaoke place?

Toshiko: Yes, it is.

Brian: Great, thanks, Toshiko!

## **Conversation 2**

Mitch: Hey Shinichi, can you help me?

Shinichi: Sure Mitch, what's up?

Mitch: I need to go to the bank but I'm not sure how to get there. Can you tell me

the best way?

**Shinichi**: Sure. When you go out of the parking lot, turn right and go straight for about 2 km. Turn right at the Lawson and go straight for about another 200 meters.

The bank is on the left.

Mitch: Great, thanks Shinichi.
