Explaining


- ✓ It's divided/broken/split into...

Focusing

- √ Notice in particular
- √ This figure represents...

Forecasting trends and changes

- √ This increase will definitely continue over the next few years
- √ This is going to fall in the future.
- √ It will rise/fall/increase/decrease...





EXAMPLE DIALOGUE

Situation 1

HR is giving a presentation on why it's important to improve your English

Jim: Hi everyone and thank you for joining this meeting. Now I'd like to present to you why it's important to improve your English. Take a look at the chart. It illustrates the growth in international employees here at Fab15 in the last five years. The horizontal axel is the increase of international employees. Also, notice this grey line. That's the number of monthly global meetings that are held exclusively in English......
