#### **INTRODUCE YOURSELF PROFESSIONALLY WITH THIS MICRON MOMENT!**

When you meet people at work for the first time, you will have to introduce yourself. This introduction may be brief, such as at the start of a global online meeting or presentation. However, it could be longer, such as when you introduce yourself at the start of a training course or at the first meeting of a new project. In each situation, you will want to create a good first impression of yourself, so it is a good idea to think about how you will introduce yourself in advance. Please see the example sentences and self-introductions below.

- √ Hi, I'm Suzanne Jones.
- √ May I call you Hiroshi?
- ✓ Please call me Suzanne.

- ✓ I work for Micron. /I'm with Micron.
- √ We are a global semiconductor company, and our head office is in the US.
- √ We produce computer memory and computer data storage, including DRAM
  and flash memory.
- √ I have been working for Micron since 2015/for five years.
- √ I have worked at Micron since 2018.
- ✓ I joined Micron in 2018.

# Your job

- √ I work as an engineer in the QE department.
- ✓ I'm an accountant in the Finance department.
- ✓ I'm with the Facilities department.
- ✓ I work in the Data Science group in the QE department.





- ✓ I'm a member of the YE group in the ADTJ PIE department
- ✓ I'm the manager of the CAD group in the TD department.
- ✓ I'm a process engineer based at Fab 15 in Hiroshima.

## Your work and responsibilities

- ✓ I'm responsible for (recruiting new team members) and (training newly hired employees).
- √ I work in (finance).
- ✓ I specialize in (yield enhancement).
- √ My work consists of/involves (checking the wafers) and (finding defects)
- √ I deal with enquiries from our customers.
- ✓ I'm in charge of a team of engineers in the TD department.
- ✓ I work with the other engineers in my department and some tool vendors.

# Introducing yourself face to face with a new business acquaintance

Hello, I'm Aki Suzuki. Please all me Aki. I work in the Finance department at the Tokyo office. I'm very pleased to meet you.

# Introducing yourself to team members from different departments in the first meeting of a new project

Hello everyone. I'm Keisuke Nagai and I'm a senior engineer in the ME department. I've been with Micron for over 20 years. I'm responsible for installing new tools in the factory and maintaining the equipment in the cleanroom. The reason I'm here is that I will be the lead engineer for this tool installation in the new building. I'm looking forward to working with all of you.

## Introducing yourself at a recruitment event for college students

Hello, I'm Hiroshi Sato and I'm a sales manager with Micron. Micron produces computer memory and computer data storage, including DRAM, flash memory and USB flash drives. I've been working for Micron for 20 years. I'm responsible for the company's international sales, so I spend a lot of time travelling and meeting customers. I'm here today to tell you more about Micron and to let you know about the employment opportunities at one of the leading global manufacturing companies.
